GROUP INVITATION CONTINUED

Seven initial groups try to meet regularly to cover a range of subjects that focus on the plan. These include Prayer, mission to families & young people, what it means to be an outward-looking Church to make Christ known, welcome, International links, Pilgrimage and Governance & buildings.. Here is a snapshot of what they have discerned.



Prayer - Reflected on different expressions of prayer, including Daily Morning Prayer, Women's Prayer Breakfast, Men's Prayer Breakfast, House group Prayer, What's App Groups, Meditation Group, Taize prayer.



Families & Children - A survey was sent to all Parish Churches to understand what support can be offered and what activities occur. Has your parish church responded?



Outward looking - Looking to create a toolkit that supports parishes thinking through what making Christ known looks like where they are and seeks to encourage ideas and thoughts that can be shared.



Welcome- They are exploring what it means to welcome, and what welcome looks like or could look like.

International Links - They have been seeking to understand the many connections already in place - Chennai Mission, Vietnamese Church, Mission Direct in Zambia. Lots of connections that we can learn and share.

Pilgrimage - This group is exploring options and looking at what Pilgrimage means for us her in our context and the Saints that have gone before us.

Buildings and governance have focused on the demands placed on our buildings, the facilities we share, reviewing the challenges of population v cost, how they are maintained and managed and the challenges that formal responsibility place on church members.
